



COVID-19 Policy & Protocols for the Big Spiel

Twin Cities Curling Association (all locations)

- In all areas that are exclusive to event participants, you will be required to wear a mask—except when eating or drinking. **This includes on the ice.**
- We are also highly encouraging players to wear masks in places where they aren't required.
- The Digital Scavenger Hunt and Circus Raffle are cancelled. Teams are no longer asked to bring a raffle prize and raffle tickets will not be distributed.
- CurlingZone results will be limited to the winner and loser of each game.
- If a player has curled during the event and subsequently tests positive, please notify a TCCA Representative immediately. The TCCA will notify the skips with an email that a player tested positive and at what clubs and times they curled.
- If a team can no longer participate during the event due to COVID-19, advise the TCCA immediately so that we can adjust the draw schedule.
- If possible, get a COVID-19 test prior to the start of the event.
- If you need to be tested while in the Twin Cities, the Minnesota Department of Health lists all testing locations here:
